Vehicles: Observer posted speed limits. Stay on designated roadways and in designated areas.

Dogs/Pets: Dogs are prohibited in botanical gardens and managed grounds. Dogs on 6 foot (or less) leashes are permitted on forested, single-track trails.

Bicycles: Bicycles not allowed on trails. All trails are hiking only.

Fires: No fires are permitted.

Picnicking: Picnicking is restricted. Call the Montalvo Association for more information (408) 961-5800.

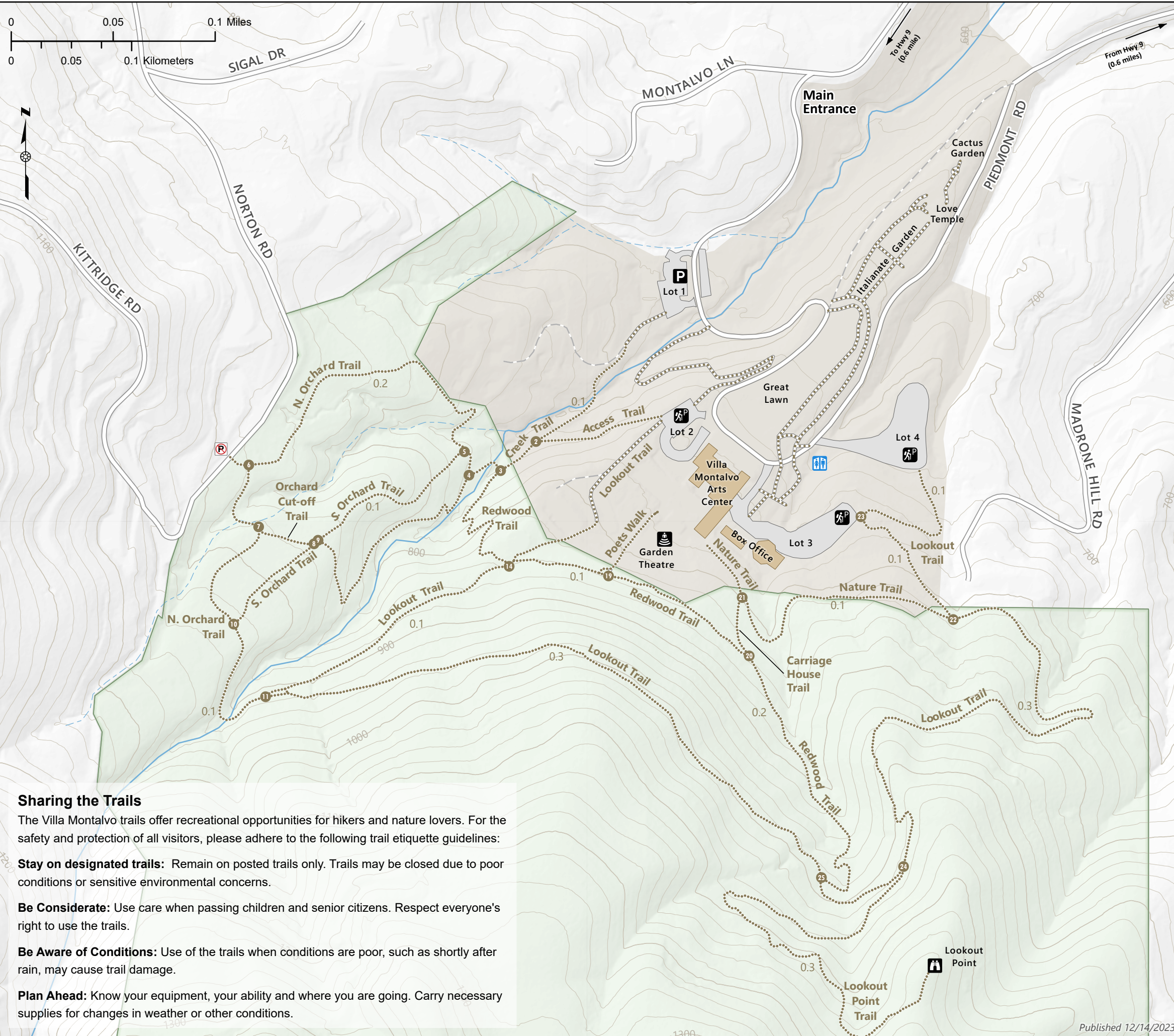
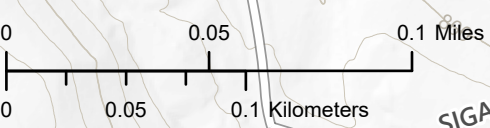
Alcohol: No alcohol is allowed on the arboretum grounds.

Sharing the Trails

The Villa Montalvo trails offer recreational opportunities for hikers and nature lovers. For the safety and protection of all visitors, please adhere to the following trail etiquette guidelines:

Stay on designated trails: Remain on posted trails only. Trails may be closed due to poor conditions or sensitive environmental concerns.

Be Considerate: Use care when passing children and senior citizens. Respect everyone's right to use the trails.

Be Aware of Conditions: Use of the trails when conditions are poor, such as shortly after rain, may cause trail damage.

Plan Ahead: Know your equipment, your ability and where you are going. Carry necessary supplies for changes in weather or other conditions.
